Glenrio – on border of Texas & New Mexico

- Ghost town ruins

Adrian, TX

- Mid Point Café – home of the “Ugly Crust Pie.” From Interstate 40 East or West at Exit #22--cafe is located on the west side of Adrian.

Vega, TX

- Restored Gas Station

Amarillo, TX

- Cadillac Ranch – approx 10 miles west of Amarillo
- Big Texan Restaurant -- Food is average; you're there for the atmosphere!
- Big Texan Motel – clean, modest rooms with western decor.

McLean, TX

- Devil's Rope Museum – Barbed wire museum
- ✓Cactus Inn Motel – Clean, charming, modest rooms in retro-style.
- ✓Red River Steakhouse -- Good food at reasonable prices

Shamrock, TX

- Tower Station, U-Drop In -- Restored Conoco Station is now the Visitor Center
- Magnolia Gas Station (restored) -- 204 N Madden Street, Shamrock, TX
